

## CLIL Mathematics Workshop: 16 May 2018

Workshop leaders: Rosie Tanner & Brian Dixon

Brian Dixon and Rosie Tanner will give a second joint workshop on CLIL maths, which will take place on **16 May 2018, 09:30-16:00 at Cals College in Nieuwegein**

The reasons for initiating the workshop are:

- a) This is the first joint seminar for CLIL mathematics given by a CLIL consultant and a specialist CLIL mathematics teacher for about 5 years. This is the second workshop in 2018, since the first one is full!
- b) For understandable reasons, Maths teachers struggle with the dual goal of teaching maths and also developing their students' language skills.

The ideas that we will develop during the workshop are:

- 1) CLIL mathematics should develop pupils' English skills.
- 2) CLIL activities do not have to take much extra effort.
- 3) Helping pupils with the language of mathematics can assist the insight in and retention of mathematics skills.
- 4) Pupils enjoy CLIL maths activities.

During the workshop we shall introduce you to a number of CLIL maths activities used successfully at Brian's school (Cals College in Nieuwegein) and other English language schools. Rosie will give her advice on language aspects, using her detailed knowledge of CLIL practice. This will include the language within mathematics: what is it and how can we help our pupils learn it.

We have also put together a booklet with more than 20 effective CLIL mathematics activities, which you can take home. More importantly, you will know that you are up to date with Clil mathematics practice!
